

1. PREAMBLE

The II Marcha Cicloturista Compostelana is organized by the **ASOCIACION CULTURAL DEPORTIVA E RECREATIVA OS ESCARAVELLOS CLUBE CICLISTA (CIF: G70537410)**.

The event is conducted in strict collaboration with the following cycling and sports clubs:

- Asociación Cultural Deportiva e Recreativa Os Escaravellos
- Club Ciclista Bicicletas Oliveira
- Club Ciclista Compostelano
- Club Ciclista BTT Ultraia
- Noitebra FC
- CC Botafumeiro
- CC Cidade de Santiago

2. DEFINITION

The Marcha Cicloturista Eurovelo Compostela is a non-competitive cycling event scheduled for June 28, 2026, departing at 09:00 from Avenida Xoan XXIII in Santiago de Compostela.

The event is classified as a "Cycling for All" activity under the "controlled speed" category. It is officially registered in the international cycling calendar and is governed by **Title XV (Cycling for All)** of the Union Cycliste Internationale (UCI) regulations and **Title X (Cycling for All / C.P.T.)** of the Royal Spanish Cycling Federation (RFEC).

The itinerary utilizes paved roads with the following technical distances:

- **Long Route:** 90.92 km
- **Short Route:** 54.43 km

3. PARTICIPATION (PARTICIPACIÓN)

Participation is conductible by all individuals meeting the following criteria:

- **Age Requirement:** Participants must have reached the age of 16 by the day of the event.
- **Capacity Limit:** For organizational and safety reasons, the total number of participants is strictly limited to **3,000 individuals**.

- **Minors:** Participants aged 16 and 17 must present a written authorization signed by a parent or legal guardian at the point of bib collection.
- **Licensing:** All participants must possess a valid federal license issued by a federation or body affiliated with the UCI. Participants without such documentation must subscribe to a "one-day license."

4. INSURANCE

Participation is conducted under the sole responsibility and at the exclusive risk of the participants. The organization assumes no liability for accidents where the participant is the cause or the victim. Valid insurance must encompass both accident coverage and civil liability.

Geographic Coverage Verification: Holders of licenses issued by bodies other than the Galician Cycling Federation must verify that their accident insurance provides explicit coverage within Galicia, specifically for medical centers in the Province of A Coruña and the immediate vicinity of Santiago de Compostela.

Participants unable to produce a valid federal license will be issued a "one-day license" during registration. This provides accident and civil liability insurance under the terms established by the Galician Cycling Federation.

- **Fee:** €15.00 (payable in addition to the registration fee).

5. SAFETY

The event adheres to current traffic regulations. The route is classified as "ordinary traffic," and the opening vehicle serves as a signaling device, not as a guarantee of traffic cessation.

Mandatory Requirements:

- **Approved Helmets:** Use of an approved protective helmet is mandatory. Non-compliance results in immediate expulsion.
- **Charged Mobile Phone:** Every participant is strictly required to carry a **fully charged mobile phone** to maintain contact with the organization or emergency services.
- **Lane Discipline:** Participants are **strictly prohibited from riding in the left lane** and must occupy the right side of the road at all times.
- **Visibility:** The participant bib must be visible at the start and all checkpoints.

Regrouping Protocols: To maintain event viability, mandatory 30-minute regrouping stops will be enforced at the following markers:

- **Touro (Long Route):** KM 32.85
- **O Pedrouzo/O Pino (Long Route):** KM 69.25
- **O Pedrouzo/O Pino (Short Route):** KM 32.55

Sanctions: The organization will impose strict penalties on participants who violate traffic codes, ignore security instructions, litter, or utilize unauthorized support vehicles.

- **Penalty:** Inclusion in a public sanctioned list and **permanent exclusion** from all future editions of the event.

6. PHYSICAL CONDITION

Upon registration, the participant formally declares they are physically and mentally fit to complete the course and possess the technical proficiency required to maintain the established average speeds.

Recommendation: The organization strongly advises a comprehensive medical examination prior to the event to detect any conditions incompatible with high-intensity cycling.

7. REGISTRATION

Registrations must be formalized via the official portal: <https://eurovelocompostela.com>. Entries are personal and non-transferable.

Included Services:

- Official Participant Bib and Route Profile.
- Finisher Medal.
- Coffee at the start line.
- Solid and liquid aid stations (Touro and O Pino).
- Liquid refreshment at the finish line (**Plaza del Obradoiro**).
- Mechanical labor assistance (excluding spare parts).
- Medical assistance (Ambulances and Physicians).
- **Runner's Bag:**

- Ottobosley Maillot (Note: Registrations after May 1 forfeit the right to size reservation).
- Maldita Buena Suerte socks.
- Energy gel and mini Santiago cake.
- **Prize Draw:** Eligibility for two bicycles valued at €9,000 each (must be present at the start).
- Shower facilities and hotel discounts for overnight stays.

Bibs must be collected at **Xoan XXIII**. Federated riders must present their license; non-federated riders must present their DNI.

Saturday, June 27:

- **16:00 – 20:00:** Bike Fair and Bib Collection.
- **18:00:** Children's Yincana (Ages up to 12; helmet and bike required).
- **20:00:** Professional Cycling Colloquium.

Sunday, June 28:

- **08:00 – 15:00:** Bike Fair.
- **09:00:** Event Commencement.

11. ROUTE AND AID STATIONS

- **Long Route:** Solid/Liquid stations in Touro and O Pedrouzo.
- **Short Route:** Solid/Liquid station in O Pedrouzo.
- **Finish line:** Liquid refreshment is provided at the **Plaza del Obradoiro** immediately after crossing the finish line at Xoan XXIII.

12. IMAGE RIGHTS

By registering, the participant authorizes the organization to utilize their likeness in any media format (radio, video, internet, etc.) for commercial or promotional purposes. This grant is provided in perpetuity without any claim to financial compensation.

13. HEALTH PROTECTION

The event is subject to UCI/RFEC regulations and health controls by the Spanish Agency for Health Protection in Sport (AEPSAD). Participation is strictly prohibited for any individual under a current or cautionary suspension for doping or health violations.

14. CIVILITY, RESPECT, AND ENVIRONMENT

Participants commit to environmental preservation by using designated waste containers at aid stations. Littering on the public way is strictly prohibited. Respectful behavior toward staff, authorities, and other participants is mandatory.
